Aged in American and French Oak barrels for twelve months. Ripe fruit bouquet with slight balsamic notes and a long smooth finish.

A rounded, smooth and oaky red with plenty of ripe raspberry and mulberry fruit.
- 98. Condado de Haza Crianza, Ribero del Duero** 2006 42.50
This intense, vibrant wine has aromas of raspberries, redcurrants, damson and hints of spice. Medium- full bodied, smooth and well- rounded.
- 99. Roda Reserva, Rioja** 2004 60.00
Complex aromas of dark fruit laced with a hint of vanilla. Rich fruit with spicy notes on the palate and exceptional length.

- 101. Prova Regia Arinto, Bucelas** 2008 27.50
Arinto is an indigenous grape variety to Portugal similar to Sauvignon Blanc. This wine has good white stone fruit flavours with a hint of green apple backed with crisp, clean acidity.
- 102. Antao Vaz da Peceguina, Alentejo** 2008 37.50
Well balanced with Chardonnay like flavours of cream and butter. Nice acidity with a touch of oak. Antao Vaz is another of Portugal's native grape varieties.

Portugal Red

- 104. Monte da Peceguina, Alentejo** 2008 37.50
Well balanced flavours of ripe, dark fruits and hints of spice.

Lebanon

- 105. Chateau Kefraya, Bekka Valley** 2003 45.00
The marriage of Cabernet Sauvignon, Mourvedre and Syrah grapes fermented and then aged in traditional casks for 16 to 18 months produce the youthful flavours of blackcurrants and prunes.

California White

- 106. Saintbury Chardonnay, Carneros** 2006 45.00
A rich, heady and complex barrel fermented and lees-aged wine of great elegance.

107. Shafer Red Shoulder Ranch Chardonnay, Napa Valley 2006 60.00
Aromas and flavours of honeysuckle, apple, apricot, and exotic flavours of the tropics. The underlying acidity is crisply integrated with warm, toasty oak, and the whole package is tied up with a long mouth-pleasing finish.

108. Saintsbury Garnet Pinot Noir, Carneros 2006 45.00
Smooth palate with aromas and flavours of wild strawberry and morello cherries with excellent length.

109. Ridge Lytton Springs 2006 65.00
This wine comprises of 77% Zinfandel, 17% Petit Syrah and 6% Carignan. This wine has spent 14 months in oak which perfectly rounds off its explosive bouquet of rich, complex and spicy berry fruit flavours from one of California's greatest wineries.

110. Ridge Geyserville 2005 65.00
